The CBH Group is an integrated grain storage, handling and marketing co-operative owned and controlled by Western Australian grain growers for their benefit. CBH is Australia's biggest co-operative and a leader in the Australian grain industry, with operations extending along the value chain from grain storage, handling and transport to marketing, shipping and processing.

Owned and controlled by over 4,700 grain growers, the core purpose of the CBH Group is to create and return value to growers.

Since being established in Western Australia in 1933, CBH has constantly evolved, innovated and grown. The Group currently employs approximately 1,000 permanent employees supported by 1,800 casual employees during harvest months. These employees are located across the State at our head office in West Perth, nine regional offices, four port terminals at Kwinana, Geraldton, Albany and Esperance, our 193 wheatbelt receival sites and our engineering workshops.

Our marketing division, CBH Grain, markets a range of grains including wheat, barley, canola, oats and lupins to more than 20 markets around the world, supported by additional offices in Eastern Australia, Hong Kong and Tokyo.
