Australia Day Honours

Congratulations to Larry Brennen OAM, Chairman of Challenge Dairy. Larry's service to the dairy industry was acknowledged in the Australia Day 2010 Honours List. A well deserved award for an industry champion and stalwart.

Co-operatives Act 2009 Update

New Western Australian specific co-operatives law received Royal Assent on 22 October 2009. As such the formal title of the legislation is the Co-operatives Act 2009, although the Act will not come into operation until it is proclaimed i.e. the Date of Proclamation.

Regulations that support the Act are being drafted based on the Queensland example, with modifications to reflect the up-dated WA law. The Department of Commerce and Co-operatives WA will review the draft regulations using a similar Industry Reference Group process to that used for the Act.

The roll-out of education around the Co-operatives Act 2009 has commenced. All co-operatives received a December 2009 newsletter from the Registrar's office covering a number of topics. Co-operatives WA and the Department have been working together on generic transition issues that will commence once the 2009 Act is proclaimed.

Proclamation of the 2009 Act will mean

- the start of the 21 month voluntary transition period;
- two Acts will coexist for a 24 month period;
- no new incorporations under the 1943 Act;
- all new incorporation to be under 2009 Act; with
- 2009 Act not applying to an existing co-operative until the co-operative has completed formal transition of incorporation from 1943 Act to 2009 Act.

The highlight of the Co-operatives WA 2009 Annual Conference was the key note presentation by Dr Fabio Chaddad from the University of Missouri.

In an information packed presentation, Fabio engaged with delegates on a range of issues. Under the title - Adapt or Die: Organisational Changes in Cooperatives - Fabio made the case that adaptation to changing contingencies (i.e. changes in the external environment and membership characteristics) is critical for any organisation to survive and grow. He put forward that evidence suggested, relatively speaking, the

- Get strategy right (external fit)
- · Get structure right (internal fit)
